Scholarship Information:

We are pleased to be able to offer qualified students (ages 3-18) who are affiliated with a school or youth program the opportunity to apply for a full scholarship to attend one of the James A. Michener Art Museum's programs. Families of all scholarship recipients will also receive a one-year Dual/Family membership to the James A. Michener Art Museum as part of the Museum's scholarship program. Scholarships are reviewed and awarded by an independent advisory board of artists and Museum staff. The awarding of scholarships is dependent on availability of sufficient funds.

If we are able to award your child a scholarship, we will try to place him/her in a program of his/her choice, but this may not always be possible. Transportation is not available. Regular attendance is required.

The James A. Michener Art Museum is an independent, non-profit organization committed to serving the community through its diverse educational arts programs.

Eligibility: Scholarships are awarded for financial need and artistic merit.

- The student has a strong interest in art.
- The student has outstanding artistic merit as demonstrated by their artwork.
- The student does not have the financial means to take advantage of our programs.
