The James A. Michener Art Museum is an independent, non-profit organization committed to expanding the role of the arts within the community, and to supporting students in the exploration of the arts. We invite you to apply to our scholarship program on behalf of your child.

About our Program

We are pleased to be able to offer qualified students (ages 6-18) who are affiliated with a school or youth program the opportunity to apply for a full scholarship to attend the Michener's creative arts classes, workshops or summer programs for one calendar year from the start date of the award.

Families of all scholarship recipients will also receive a one-year Dual/Family membership to the James A. Michener Art Museum as part of the Museum's scholarship program.

This will enable awardee families the opportunity to share the excitement of the Museum with their children. Families will also enjoy all the benefits of membership at both the Doylestown and New Hope locations, including free admissions, discounts on programs, special savings in the Museum shops, and invitations to members' previews and special events. The Museum is a great place for families and friends to spend time together.

Eligibility

Full scholarships will be awarded to eligible students between the ages of 6 – 18. Scholarship eligibility is based on **financial need and merit**. Museum employees and their children are not eligible for any scholarship funds. Scholarships are reviewed and awarded by an independent advisory board of artists and Museum staff. The James A. Michener Art Museum is an independent, non-profit organization committed to serving the community through its diverse educational arts programs.

How to Apply:

1. Applications should be made by the parent/guardian on behalf of the child. Sponsors - principals, teachers, school counselors and youth program directors – may also initiate the scholarship application procedure.
2. Parents / guardians must complete two forms: the Parent / Guardian Recommendation Form and the Art Education Scholarship Application. Sponsors complete the Sponsor Recommendation Form.

3. Applications must accompany the registration form for the program in which the child is interested.
